

Within a 5 year period after receiving your license, you will need to get a total of 15 continuing education units (CEUs) with at least 2 hours in Laws/Regulations and 2 hours in Integrated Pest Management to keep your license active.

SBA acted under its own authority to declare a disaster following the denial of the state's request for a major disaster declaration for individual assistance on Feb. 27, 2019.

"Low-interest federal disaster loans are available to businesses of all sizes, most private nonprofit organizations, homeowners and renters whose property was damaged or destroyed by this disaster," said SBA's Director Tanya N. Garfield of the U.S. Small Business Administration's Disaster Field Operations Center-West. "Beginning Tuesday, March 12, 2019, SBA representatives will be on hand at the following Disaster Loan Outreach Centers to answer questions about SBA's disaster loan program, explain the application process and help each individual complete their application," Garfield continued.
